ORDER

Read the averments made in the complaint and the report received from Respondent Superintendent of Police, Nashik (Rural). Read the case papers. Heard the parties.

2. The complainant Md.Harun resides on the given address along with his family members. Md Arif is his son. That on 22.07.2007 at about 9.30 p.m. he



was returning home. When he reached near Lucky Hotel, noted criminal S K Tayyab and his friend S K Babu abused and beaten him. Md Arif went in Police Station Yeola to lodge the complaint. When complainant went in Police Station Yeola, Police also beaten him and kept in lock up. The complainant got injury near left eye. They both were medically examined. The Medical Officer issued certificates. It was alleged by the complainant that Police joined hands with other side and unnecessarily beaten them and kept them in lock up. Therefore, they moved the Commission for necessary action in this matter.

3. The Respondent Superintendent of Police, Nashik (Rural) by filing their report denied and disputed all the allegations made against them in the complaint. According to them the complainant till today did not file any complaint against Police in Police Station and secondly no independent eye witness did tell that these Police Officials abused and beaten the complainant and his son.

4. The complainant supported his case by filing affidavit. The complainant had no reason to speak against Police or to make allegations against Police. Moreover, the case of the complainant that he and his son were beaten by Police, they got injuries etc. is fully supported by the Medical certificates and the photographs. I therefore, see no reason to disagree with the submissions, made by the complainant. Thus, the complainant prima facie established case of harassment, ill treatment at the hands of Police.

5. I therefore, make following recommendations in this matter.

- (i) The complainant to give proper complaint of this incident to Superintendent of Police, Nashik (Rural).
- (ii) On receipt of this complaint, Superintendent of Police, Nashik (Rural) to do inquiry in this matter and if necessary to take proper action according to law.

(iii) Copy of this complaint be sent to Superintendent of Police, Nashik (Rural) through Secretary – State Human Rights Commission, Mumbai for information and necessary action. Compliance may be reported.

With these observations and recommendations the Case No. 2986/2007-08 is disposed of accordingly.
